Public Rights-of-Way

This map shows the Public Rights-of-Way which are in general use. The path numbers are taken from the definitive map.

The arrows indicate the continuation of a path in a neighbouring parish.

A single rectangle is used to represent a selection of farm and other buildings which are footpath landmarks.

The 'Guide to the Footpaths of Copdock and Washbrook', published by the Parish Council, gives further details.
